





The Indiana Department of Transportation (INDOT) has made available for public comment a new State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP). The STIP lists all state projects and project phases expected to be funded within 5-years with federal funds as well as state-funded projects that has been deemed Regionally Significant. The Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) invites comment on the development of guidance for two new electric vehicle charging station programs included in the recently enacted Bipartisan Infrastructure Law: the National Electric Vehicle Formula Program, and the Charging and Fueling Infrastructure discretionary grant program.
