Partnership Brings Electric Hybrid Buses to IndyGo



Allison Transmission has announced that, in partnership with Cummins and GILLIG, 24 electric hybrid buses have been delivered to IndyGo. This system improves fuel consumption compared to a conventional diesel bus and reduces CO₂ emissions. In addition, beginning in 2022, Allison's next generation eGen Flex™ electric hybrid system with geofence technology will be integrated into three of IndyGo's new buses, providing full electric operation for up to 10 miles.
